




We aim to ensure that children leave St Mary & St Paul's with an excellent grasp of the key basic skills—reading, writing and maths—and also with a broad knowledge and understanding of the wider curriculum—areas such as history, geography, music ,

P.E. and R.E. To achieve this, we use a topic-based approach to most of our teaching.



## Church links

Our school has a caring and inclusive Christian ethos. We have really good links with our local churches - the Parish Church of St Mary in the centre of Prescott and St Paul's Church, which is very close to school. We enjoy going across to St Paul's Church for special services such as Harvest Festival, Christmas and Easter, and we join with many other schools in the Diocese in attending the annual Leavers' Service in the Anglican Cathedral.



## School Uniform


