

Maths number cards

Activities and outcomes from using the number cards:

- Counting forwards 0-10
- Counting backwards 10-0
- Number recognition – mixing numbers up and being able to read the number.
- Number formation – being able to write the numeral correctly.
- Ordering numbers 0-5 – To mix numbers up and being able to put them in order from smallest to biggest and biggest to smallest.
- Ordering numbers cards 0- 10 – Again mix them up and being able to put them in order from smallest to biggest and biggest to smallest.
- Identifying quantities to numbers – Children recognising numbers and counting objects to match (EG – number 5 – counting matching 5 grapes to the number)
- Counting quantities from a larger number – Having a bowl of objects and can they count out a number from the larger quantity. (Eg, 20 objects in a bowl, “Can you count out 5 pegs for me?” “Can you get one more?” “How many have you got now?” You “Have too many, What do you need to do so you have the right amount?”
- Number bonds to 5 – Identifying what two numbers can be added together to make 2,3,4 and 5.
- Number bonds to 10 – Identifying what two numbers can be added together to make 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,and 10.
