

HOME LEARNING

First of all, I would just like to say, please keep yourselves safe during this time. As a school, we will be giving you updates via text message and through our school website so please make sure we have your up to date details. If your details change, please contact school and let us know.

This is your child's home learning pack for you to work through with your child. I have included:

- **Yellow Workbook** – some resources sheets have already been stuck into your book to start off.
- **A classroom secrets resource pack** – This includes several problem cards that you can work through over the next few weeks.
- **Pencil control activities** – To help support children's pencil control and pencil grip ready for writing.
- **A home reader** - We have included a family reading book that you can use as a family for reading time
- **Number cards** – I have included number cards 0-10. These can be used in a range of ways which have been detailed in the attached sheet to the cards.
- **Name card** - I have included the children's 'first name' for them to practice daily. One of the expectations is to be able to write their name, first using a name card then onto independently. If they are achieving this move onto their surname.
- **Internet websites and apps.** – I have included a list of websites and apps that we use in school to support

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children's learning. The majority of these are few and available to all.

Weekly, I will be uploading new home learning ideas, onto our website, so keep an eye out for activities that you could be doing at home to support your child's early years development.
