Can you design a poster that shows everything you know about division; this might include diagrams or methods?</p> <p><b><u>Time</u></b> Practise telling the time. Give yourself a random number, and round it to the nearest 10. For example, 452 to the nearest 10 is 450. Can you create a poster to help Year 2, round to the nearest 10?</p>	<p>You could share a story together.
