Dear Parents and Carers,

You will now be well aware that the Government guidance on the reopening of school indicates that from 1<sup>st</sup> June they should be open to increase the number of classes and children that attend on a daily basis.

You will have seen from the letter sent out to parents yesterday that we feel that it is important to take this slowly, ensuring that the school site is as safe as possible for all students, staff and parents as we transition to a new way of being in school.

In the light of this, from 2<sup>nd</sup> June (1<sup>st</sup> June being a staff INSET training day) we are planning to open school for the children of key workers and those classed in the vulnerable category who have been **currently** accessing school. Many of you will have accessed this provision over the past number of weeks to a greater or lesser degree and we are keen to ensure that this continues to support our families.

The format of the school days will then change with us moving to a class 'bubble' where children will immediately go into their room, with their key workers, and remain in that group all day / week. The guidance sent out previously will explain this in greater detail.

Initially, we will be running 4 'bubbles' in school. One for Nursery/Reception / Year 1; another for Years 2 and 3, the third for Years 4, 5 and 6 and another for Nurture.

This provision will now be available on a full time basis. Children will be expected to go back to wearing school uniform if at all possible. **We will advise you about the arrangements for your child on an individual basis, this will come as a separate letter.**

Please be aware that at the start of the school day, parents will not be able to come on to the school site and children will be met at the gate by a member of staff and brought up to school. Whilst waiting outside the school grounds, we would ask that each family group (only one parent per family) follows the guidance and remain separated at a distance of 2m apart.

Collection at the end of the day will be from the school playground via the gates on the school field (please again ensure that you are socially distanced from other families)

We would be grateful if you would contact school at [admin@stmaryandstpauls.org.uk](mailto:admin@stmaryandstpauls.org.uk) to indicate if you will be accessing school from 2<sup>nd</sup> June and whether this will be full time. Once again we would like to thank you for your support, patience and encouragement during this time.
