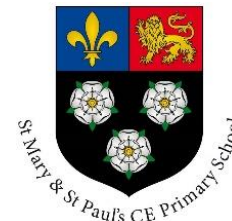


St Mary & St Paul's CE Primary Governing Body Committees



Terms of Reference – Quality of Education

Membership

The committee will comprise of 6 (six) governors, one of whom shall be the Headteacher.

The membership and Terms of Reference of the Committee shall be reviewed annually.

The quorum will be 3 (three) Governors.

Terms of Reference

- a. To monitor key performance indicators for pupil achievement (identified below) and provide support and challenge for the Headteacher and school leaders in improving and/or maintaining high standards in these areas (Fed from Standing committee)
- b. To receive and, as appropriate, respond to regular reports from the Headteacher on the outcomes of monitoring activities undertaken by the Headteacher, school leaders and external advisers/consultants, including reports on the quality of teaching and learning in the school
- c. To advise the Governing Body on the school's curriculum statement and their statutory obligations regarding the National Curriculum.
- d. To monitor and review all school policies linked to teaching, learning and the curriculum and make recommendations. Policies include:
 - Numeracy and Literacy Policy
 - Curriculum Subject Policies
 - Teaching and Learning
 - Subject Leadership
- e. To ensure that the requirements of children identified on the register of Special Educational Needs are met.
- f. To advise the governing body on the National Curriculum framework and the Curriculum guidance for the foundation stage and their associated assessment arrangements.
- g. To monitor and evaluate curriculum action plans

- h. To support and challenge the monitoring of core curriculum areas and SEND
- i. To have a clear overview of the quality assurance of subject assessments within the school.
- j. To oversee how remote learning will be delivered and the effectiveness of systems
- k. To consider and report back upon such matters as may be delegated or devolved to the committee by the Governing Body.
- l. To present minutes of meetings to the Governing Body.
