<p><b>Communication and Language - Understanding</b></p>	<p>Using language in recalling past experiences. Retelling simple past events in correct order. Using talk to explain what is happening and what will happen next. Beginning to use a range of tenses. Questions why things happen and gives explanations.</p>	<p>Listens and responds to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion. Understands questions such as who; why; when; where and how?</p>
<p><b>Mathematics - Measures</b></p>	<p>Recalling a sequence of events in everyday life and stories.</p>	<p>Is increasingly able to order and sequence events using everyday language related to time. Beginning to experience measuring time with timers and calendars.</p>
<p><b>UTW - People &amp; Communities/ The World</b></p>	<p>Enjoy joining in with family customs and routines. Talks about significant events in their own experiences. Recognising and describing special times or events with family and friends. Knowing some of the things that make them unique and can talk about some of the similarities and differences in relation to friends or family.</p>	<p>Enjoys joining in with family customs and routines. Talks about past and present events in their own life and in the lives of family members. Knows about similarities and differences between themselves and others, and among families, communities, cultures and traditions. Knows about similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things.</p>
