Continuing to explore moving in a range of ways, creating own patterns. Enjoying joining in with moving, dancing and ring games. Singing familiar songs daily. Tapping out simple repeated rhythms. Developing and understanding of how to create and use sounds intentionally.</p> <p>Using movement and sounds to express experiences, expertise, ideas and feelings. Experimenting and creating movement in response to music, stories and ideas. Sings to self and makes simple songs. Creates sounds, movements, drawings to accompany stories.</p>	<p>Begins to build a collection of songs and dances. Makes music in a range of ways, e.g. plays with sounds creatively, plays along to the beat of the song they are singing or music they are listening to. Expresses and communicates working theories, feelings and understandings using a range of art forms, e.g. movement, dance, drama, music and the visual arts. Music is taught using the Charanga Scheme of Learning. Children will sing throughout the day.</p> <p>Chooses particular movements, instruments/ sounds, colours and materials for their own imaginative purposes. Uses combinations of art forms, e.g. moving and singing, making and dramatic play. Responds imaginatively to art works and objects, e.g. this music sounds like dinosaurs.</p>
